WHAT KIND OF BOOK IS THE BIBLE?

PURPOSE OF THE COURSE

To impress on the student that the Bible is the book we study. To give the student some ideas, on his level of understanding, of the message of the Bible for us. This purpose, that is expressed in the title, What Kind of Book is the Bible?, should be emphasized in every lesson.

ORGANIZATION OF THE COURSE

This course is divided by themes. There are four parts with five or six lessons plus a review in each part. You should remember the general outline of the course when you teach each lesson. In the development of each lesson, the teacher should remember these things: the Bible story that is given, the title of the lesson, and in which of the 4 parts the story is. Encourage the students to memorize the titles.

PART I -- THE BIBLE TELLS US WHAT GOD IS LIKE

Lesson 1

Theme: The Bible tells us that God sees everything -- Jonah 1,2,3.

Application

The Bible tells us that God sees everything that we do.

Study helps

Explain:

casting lots—deciding something by chance, as objects taken, one per person from a container; or the choosing of slips of paper; or choosing of straws. In each case one of the objects, slips of paper or straws is different from the others. The one choosing the different object is the one chosen for a particular job, or as in Jonah's case, the one to blame for the storm. Sometimes God worked through this method to carry out something He wished done.

Discuss with the children the topic on the work sheet: the times God sees you. We don't have to be afraid if we are doing what is right.

Bible drill

This course is an excellent one to include learning the books of the Bible and having a short Bible drill on the theme of the lesson. A few suggested verses are included with the helps for each lesson.

Most of the lessons have two work sheets. Basically, there is one that is a large picture to be colored in a variety of ways designed with the younger (5-8 year olds) in mind. The other sheet contains work for the older students. The older students (9-12 year olds) could do both sheets. You can, of course, use your judgment according to the make-up of your class.

It is a good practice to have a folder for each student into which he will put his completed work sheets each week until the review lesson. At that time they can be fastened together with the cover page and taken home.

train of a robe--a long part in the back that drags on the floor when the person walks, or that may be draped around his/her feet when he/she sits. seraphim--a kind of creature that lives and serves God in heaven.

holy--perfect, pure, without any sin or anything wrong.

The Bible tells us where, when and how people began to live on the earth. We are all descendants of Adam and Eve.

Study helps

Explain:

ancestor -- the person or persons from whom we come, ex. mother, father, grandmother, grandfather, great grandmother, great grandfather, etc. all the way back to Adam and Eve.

descendant -- the person born after another in the family, ex. son, daughter, granddaughter, grandson, great granddaughter, great grandson, etc.

The memory verses for Part II Younger are all found on one of the Pages of extra things, Part II. The student fills his name in the blank, cuts it out and pastes it on the work sheet. Another work sheet for older students.

Lesson 9

Theme: The Bible tells us that we are a body and a soul -- Lazarus--John 11:1-45.

Application

The Bible tells us that each person is a soul that lives in his body.

Study helps

Explain:

soul—that part of people that is different from animals. With the soul we are able to think and feel. When a person dies, his soul leaves his body. When Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead, Lazarus' soul returned to his body and made him alive again.

Younger--You will need a sheet of plain paper for each student for this project. Use the figures on work sheet #9 to make a picture of Lazarus coming out of the tomb. (The page of extra things for the review lessons, Lesson 13 has a small picture that you can use as a pattern.) When cutting out the stones, cut them in pairs before class time. Make the background inside the tomb black. Paste Lazarus in the doorway. Paste the title and verse (the student filling in his name) on the work sheet also. Another work sheet for the older students.

Theme: The Bible tells us that we sin -- Children make fun of Elisha -- 2 Kings 2:23-24.

Application

The Bible tells us that everyone sins.

Study helps

Explain:

sin--anything a person does that God has said in the Bible he should not do or anything that a person fails to do that God has said he should do.

The student constructs the scene on a plain piece of paper on which he also pastes the title and verse (filling in his name).

Application

The Bible tells us that we can have our sin forgiven.

Explain:

prodigal--a person who is wasteful of his money, time, strength.

Theme: Review

On the Page of extra things for the review lessons there are 5 small pictures to be pasted in the correct places on the review sheet. There is only one work sheet for this lesson.

Each student can draw himself on the cover for Part II.

PART III -- THE BIELE TELLS US WHAT WE MUST BELIEVE

Lesson 14

Theme: The Bible tells us not to believe Satan -- Temptation of Jesus --Matthew 4:1-11.

Application

The Bible tells us NOT to believe Satan. He is a liar.

Study helps

Explain:

tempt--is to try to get a person to do something wrong, evil, or sinful.

Bible drill

John 8:44 (memory verse) 2 Thessalonians 2:9,10 Revelation 12:9 Matthew 4:8-10 1 John 3:8

Visual aids

In the packet, there are 3 figures representing the 3 temptations that Satan gave to Jesus. They can be mounted on light cardboard as flash cards or placed on the slot board.

Work sheets

The students are to draw the places of the temptations of Jesus. There is another work sheet for the older students.

After each lesson, have the students print the name of the person (ex. Satan, Jesus, false prophets, apostles, God) under YES or NO on the cover page for this Part III. The word for this lesson: Satan

Lesson 15

Theme: The Bible tells us not to believe false prophets -- Prophet of Bethel --1 Kings 13:1-32.

Application

The Bible tells us NOT to believe false prophets. This includes people today who claim to have visions and dreams from God.

Study helps

Explain:

prophet --a true prophet spoke the words of God. A false prophet is someone who says he is speaking for God but God never told him anything. He is lying.

On the visual aid pages there are 2 figures (king & altar with sacrifice). Use the figures on the work sheet to make the rest of the visual aid.

Work sheets

This work sheet is in two parts, a regular-sized page and a half page (found on Page of extra things, Part III) that has to be pasted to the larger page. On another Page of extra things, Part III, there are patterns for the clothes of the two prophets. These can be cut from cloth or colored paper and pasted to the work sheet. Cut around the prophet's hands and also the solid lines of his robe so that his hands can be seen. Another work sheet for the older students. Cover: false prophets

Lesson 16

Theme: The Bible tells us to believe God -- The bronze serpent --Numbers 21:4-9.

Application

The Bible tells us to believe God. If we believe God we will do whatever He says in the Bible.

Bible drill

Isaiah 43:10 (memory verse) 2 Chronicles 20:20 Acts 16:34

Visual aids

On the visuals pages there are figures of Moses, fiery serpents and bronze serpent to make flannelgraph.

Work sheets

On the work sheet with the picture, have the students draw the fiery serpents. There is another work sheet for the older students. Cover: God

Theme: The Bible tells us to believe Jesus -- Feeds 5,000 --John 6:1-15, 22-59.

Application

The Bible tells us to believe Jesus. That means we have to listen to what He has said in the Bible and obey Him.

The pieces of the puzzle are on a Page of extra things, Part III. The teacher should have the verse puzzles cut out ahead of time so all the students have to do is paste the pieces in the right place on the guide page. Another work sheet for older students.

Lesson 18

Theme: The Bible tells us to believe the apostles -- Pentecost -- Acts 1,2.

Application

The Bible tells us to believe the apostles. Jesus chose the apostles, taught them many things and the Holy Spirit came on them in a miraculous way so that they could teach others the truth that God wanted people to know.

Study helps

Explain:

apostle—a special messenger chosen directly by Jesus. There are no living apostles today but we have the apostles' message written in the New Testament. By reading the New Testament we can listen to the apostles' message from God.

Bible drill

Acts 2:41,42 (memory verse)

Visual aids

Make 12 large silhouettes of men (see work sheet) to represent the 12 apostles. Also make 12 cards with their names. Use them on the slot board made with horizontal open strips to drill the students to learn the names of the 12 apostles. Teach them Matthias instead of Judas Iscariot since he lost his apostleship.

Work sheets

Have the students paste a name (found on Page of extra things, Part III) on the silhouette of each apostle. Another page for older students. Cover: the apostles

Lesson 19

Theme: Review

Cross marks and stars are found on Page of extra things for the review lessons. Students paste them in the correct place on the work sheet. Only 1 work sheet.

Lesson 20

Theme: The Bible tells us not to disobey -- Saul -- 1 Samuel 15.

Application

The Bible tells us not to disobey. That means we have to obey God, our parents, our teachers, or whoever is over us.

Study helps

Use the work sheet for the older students as a help in class discussion.

Bible drill

After the students have colored and cut out Saul (Page of extra things, Part IV) cut out the tab #20. Fold back and forth. Paste one end to the square on the work sheet and the other end to the back of Saul. This makes the figure stand out from the scene. Other work sheet for older students. Each week have the students print the key word on the cover page in the correct place. Key word today under NO: disobey

Theme: The Bible tells us not to fight -- Paul -- Acts 14:1-20.

Application

The Bible tells us not to fight.

Study helps

James 4:1-3 tells where fighting comes from.

Use the work sheet for the older students as a help in class discussion.

Use the work sheet for the older students as a help in class discussion.

Paste the stolen things on the circle on the work sheet and fold the earth over it. Then, color and fold tent and paste it over the covered hole on the guide lines. Another work sheet. Cover key word: steal.
