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WHO IS JESUS?

PURPOSE OF THE COURSE

To learn who and what Jesus is. To start the students on the road to understanding the depth of meaning of Jesus' nature and His work.

ORGANIZATION OF THE COURSE

This course is divided into four parts. When the students finish this course they should know the important characteristics of Jesus and they should remember some of the stories that illustrate these characteristics. The memory verses are very important. All scripture is taken from the New King James Version.

TEACHER'S HELPS

WHO IS JESUS?

The materials for this course make it possible to use it in 3 ways: A group of students (5 to 12 years old) using both worksheets; A group of younger students (5 to 8) using the easy worksheets; A group of older students (9 to 12) using only the more difficult worksheet or both.

All scriptures are taken from the New King James Version

PART 1

JESUS IS THE SON OF GOD, THE CHRIST

Lesson 1

Theme: Jesus proved it by His wisdom -- Woman at the well -- John 4:1-42

Application

We believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, because He knows all things and uses His knowledge wisely.

Study helps

"Christ" is the Greek form, "Messiah" is the Hebrew, "the anointed one" is the English--all translations of the same word. John 4:25; 1:41. Anoint means to pour something over a person to set him aside for a special job or to give him a special power. In the Bible people were anointed with oil and the Holy Spirit. The special kinds of people who were anointed with oil in the Old Testament were: prophet 1 Kings 19:16; priest--Exodus 30:30; king--1 Samuel 10:1,21-24. Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit Acts 4:25-27; 10:38.

The Jews for centuries had been waiting for God's Messiah to come to save them from their enemies and to set up His kingdom. They did not understand that the Messiah was coming to set up a spiritual kingdom. Nor did they understand that He was coming to die for the sins of the world.

In each of the lessons be sure to call attention to who the people in the story think Jesus is--Christ, Messiah, Son of God.

Visual aids

Make the large letter banner title, Jesus is the Son of God, the Christ. See the Page of instructions for making the banner titles. This is the coloring project for the younger students. Call attention to it; read it each lesson; have the class repeat it.

Chart--Make a large copy of the project chart to fill in during the appropriate classes. If you make the words detachable they can be removed and replaced during review.

Memory verse

Younger--Each lesson worksheet has a shortened version of the memory verse. Older--Each worksheet will have a verse maize. With a pencil the student draws a continuous line from the first word of the verse to the second, to the third, etc. until he gets to the reference. Then he copies the verse in the correct order and memorizes it. The verse for Lesson 1 is John 4:25,26.

Verse booklets for Part 1--There are separate booklets for the younger and older students. To assemble before class: Cut on the lines. Staple the small pages in order with the cover on the front and the blank page at the end. The blank page can be used at a lesson later in Part 1--students who learn verses quickly can copy a verse chosen by the teacher from verses in the Bible drills to learn for extra commendation. Distribute the booklets at the end of class for the students to take home to study both after the lesson and ahead of the next lesson.

Worksheet

All students paste the symbol in 3 languages(Greek [Christ], Hebrew [Messiah], Christ [English]) for Lesson 1 on a top corner of the worksheet or other suitable space. See Study Helps page 1 about the languages.

Younger -- a dot to dot picture of a well.

Older--the main exercise is a list of 6 words from the story which each student is to use to write questions about the story on his worksheet. When all have finished making their questions they can take turns asking them of other students.

Bible drill

A list of scriptures is provided with each lesson on the subject of that lesson. Use them as a short Bible drill, reading carefully the verses when found and noting how it repeats the theme and application of the lesson.

<u>Project</u>

Younger--Have the younger students color the large letters of the banner title for Part 1 (see visual aids). Teach them to read these important words.

Older--The project for this course is a chart/poster to show who Jesus is. A completed pattern is included on a separate page. The incomplete chart to be photo copied for each student is on another page. Each lesson will tell what should be filled in for that lesson. Each student cuts out the words and symbols for that lesson and pastes them in the correct spaces. The spaces have the numbers of the lessons. The use of colored outlines around the words would make the chart even more attractive.

Words for Lesson 1: The Christ and symbol in 3 languages plus anointed.

In connection with the chart and at any other time during the class sessions ask the question: Where does it say in the Bible that Jesus is _____? This is a way of reviewing the memory verses and any other verses that were used in the Bible drill or the story.

Lesson 2

Theme: Jesus proved it by healing the sick -- Man born blind -- John 9

Application

We believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, because He had power on earth to heal any and all kinds of diseases and deformities. Study helps

Be prepared to compare Jesus' healings with present-day so-called healers.

<u>JESUS</u> Healed all he tried to heal.

Healed all kinds of diseases and deformities.

Raised the dead. Immediate healing.

Complete healing.

Healed in all kinds of places-wherever He was. Did not demand faith of person to be healed. TODAY

Really heal very few and make excuses for failures. Claim all kinds except deformities. Teach people to say healed even though still sick, blind, deaf, etc. Never attempt. Claim immediate of sicknesses that no one can see. Claim gradual healing of others. (This is no different from what doctors do) Teach people to say healed even though not well. Only attempt healing in set, preannounced places. Say sick must have faith to be healed; failure?-say sick person lacked faith.

Memory verse

Verse maize--see Lesson 1. Verse for Lesson 2 is John 9:35-37. Remind students to study the verses at home from their verse booklets.

Worksheet

All students paste the symbol Son of God for Lesson 2 top corner. Younger--pictures (on Pages of extra things) to paste in correct order.

Lesson 3

Theme: Jesus proved it by raising the dead -- The widow's son -- Luke 7:11-22

Application

We believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, because He had power to raise people from the dead.

Study helps

Death happens when the spirit leaves the body. James 2:26. Resurrection is when the spirit returns to the body. Luke 8:55. Our body is just the "house" where we are living in this world. 2 Cor. 5:1.

Refer to Study helps Lesson 1. Talk about the fact that one of the works of God's Anointed one was to be a prophet. Review the meaning of anointed. John the Baptist asked Jesus if He was the Coming One, meaning the Christ. Memory verse Verse maize--Luke 7:16.

Worksheet

All students paste the symbol in 3 languages plus Coming One for Lesson 3. Younger--Color and cut out the figures for Lesson 3 (Pages of extra things). Fasten the upper part of the man to the worksheet by using the open end of a paper clip. From the back of the page, use the clip to puncture the work sheet at the dot and then through the dot on the figure. The figure will then lie in the casket or sit up. Paste a small piece of paper over the clip on the back of the page so it will stay flat. Next paste the front of the casket (on the edges only) where it says paste on the worksheet.

Theme: Jesus proved it by fulfilling prophecy

Preaching in Nazareth -- Luke 4:14-30

Application

We believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, because He did exactly what the prophecies, written hundreds of years before He came to earth, said the Messiah would do.

Study helps

Fulfilled means that something is done the way it was said it should and would be done.

Refer to Study helps Lesson 1. Talk about the fact that one of the works of God's Anointed one was to be priest and king. Review anointed.

The older student's worksheet contains 5 of the easier prophecies to understand. They are the first 5 listed below. Another 4 are also given here.

Theme: Jesus proved it in the transfiguration -- Matthew 17:1-13

Application

We believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, because God spoke from heaven to tell which of the three important men on the mountain was His Son and to tell us to listen to Him.

Study helps

Give a brief summary of the life of Moses and Elijah, beginning by asking the students what they know about each one. Be sure to include the items mentioned on the older student's worksheet.

2 Peter 1:16-18 is Peter's testimony of the transfiguration.

We believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, because of many strong, important proofs, but the greatest is that He Himself raised from the dead like He said He would and He never died again.

Study helps

Lesson 7

Theme: Review

Older--symbol on worksheet, 3 languages plus Son of God. All students-- paste the symbols for Part 1 on the cover.

Teacher--To prepare for younger students: Before class, cut out the picture of the empty tomb on the border line. Mount it on cardboard. Punch out the circles with a a ballpoint pen or other similar sharp round object. Make the holes large enough for the yarn to pass through easily. For each student, prepare 2 pieces of yarn 36 inches long. Tie a knot at one end (Make it large enough so it will not pass through the holes). Wrap the other end tightly with scotch tape to make a "needle".

Younger students--outline the stone and the tomb by "sewing" with the yarn.

Older--an acrostic puzzle. Check chart to see what is lacking of things to be filled in for Part 1.

Review with questions like: Who is Jesus? How did He prove it? Where does it say in the Bible that Jesus is.....? Where does it say in the Bible that Jesus did.....? Repeat all the memory verses.

PART 2 -- JESUS IS THE SAVIOR

Lesson 8

<u>Theme:</u> Jesus was to be the Savior according to God's plan --An angel talks to Joseph -- Matthew 1:18-25

An angel announces Jesus' birth--Luke 2:8-17

Application

We believe Jesus is the Savior because it was God's plan for Him to be Savior.

Study helps

Background--Luke 1:26-38; 2:11--message to Mary and the shepherds. Explain:

Savior--one who saves someone from danger, injury, death. Jesus saves us from the eternal punishment of the second death because of sin. The name Jesus means Savior. Redeemer--(Isaiah 59:20) one who pays the price to get something back; to rescue from sin.

In every lesson call attention to who people say Jesus is. Are they right?

Visual aids

Large letter banner title--Jesus is the Savior.

Project--continue to fill in the large teacher's chart Who is Jesus?

Worksheet

The 2 symbols for Lesson 8 are the cross and the words Savior, Christ, Lord. On all worksheets of Part 2, paste cross symbol by the word Savior in the title.

Memory verse

Verse maize--Matthew 1:20,21

Assemble and distribute the verse booklets for Part 2 for the students to take home to study both after the lesson and ahead of the next lesson. There are separate booklets for the younger and older students.

Lesson 9

Theme: Jesus is called the Lamb of God -- John the Baptist -- John 1:19-41

Application

We believe Jesus is the Savior because John the Baptist, who came to prepare the people for His coming, called Him the Lamb of God.

Study helps

Exodus chapters 11 & 12, & 29:38-41 give the background of lamb sacrifice. In the Old Testament a sacrifice was to kill and burn an animal as worship to God. When Jesus died on the cross, His blood was spilled like the lambs of the Old Testament. Both were for the forgiveness of sin, however we don't sacrifice lambs now because Jesus was our lamb who had to die only once.

Call attention to Jesus being called not only the Lamb of God but also Messiah and Christ (v.41) in this story.

Lesson 12

Theme: Jesus died on the cross to take away our sins --Matthew 27:11-61 and 28:1-10 Application

We believe Jesus is the Savior because He died on a cross to take away our sins like He said but He also rose from the dead like He said. If He had not risen He would not be able to save us.

Study helps

Background--Matthew 26:36--27:10.

Jesus is called the lamb, the good shepherd, the High Priest. He is everything we need. Explain that Jesus is our high priest (Hebrews 9:11,12) which is another part of being Christ (see Study helps Lesson 1, three kinds of people anointed). He offered himself as a sacrifice. He was both the priest and the lamb that was sacrificed. (See Lesson 9 Study helps)

Memory verse

Worksheet

All-symbols--cross, empty tomb.

Younger--Fill the cross by pasting toothpicks on it. Use them both whole or broken. First, put paste on the cross. Then, lay toothpicks on the paste.

Younger--A sewing card picture of a cross. Older--acrostic puzzle. Check to see that the chart project is up-to-date. Other ideas in Lesson 7.

PART 3 -- JESUS IS MASTER TEACHER AND LORD

Lesson 14

Theme: Jesus taught that He was the Teacher and the Lord Washes disciples' feet -- John 13:1-17

Application

We believe in Jesus because He was the Teacher and Lord who taught the truth by word and by example. Study helps

Make special note that the disciples were calling Jesus, "Teacher and Lord". He did not refuse this but said they were right--verse 13. This goes with His teaching of Matthew 23:10. He is the head teacher, the master teacher. He is the Guide, commander and instructor. Lord means one who is in charge, one who is Master above others who are his servants (v.16), one who has great authority and power.

Many people have become confused by this story, thinking that Jesus is teaching that we are supposed to wash each others feet as a ceremony in the church. However, what Jesus means when He says, "I have set you an example," (verse 15) is that we are to serve one another in whatever someone has need. In that day the people wore open sandals as they walked the dusty unpaved roads, streets and paths. When someone arrived at your house, the custom of courtesy was to provide that their feet were washed. If Jesus, the Master Teacher and Lord could get down and do a humble service for others by washing their dirty feet, we should certainly not think we are too good to be willing to serve others.

In every lesson call attention to who people say Jesus is. Are they right?

Visual aids

Large letter banner title--Jesus is Master Teacher and the Lord. Project--continue to fill in the chart Who is Jesus?.

Memory verse

Older--Each week have the students read the true statement about Jesus above the puzzle. Then with a dark crayon they are to blot out the words of this sentence in their puzzle. The words that are left make the memory verse for this lesson--John 13:13.

Assemble and distribute the verse booklets for Part 3.

Worksheet

All--symbols: scroll, Teacher and Lord (Master).

Younger--Cut pieces of terry cloth or some other similar kind for the students to paste on the towel in the picture.

We believe in Jesus because He taught with such wisdom and authority that the people were amazed. Study helps

Explain:

wisdom--the ability to understand, to use common sense, to explain and to put into practice important teachings.

Refer to the instructions in Lesson 14. Matthew 7:28,29.

Lesson 16

Theme: Jesus proved His teaching was true ---

The paralyzed man -- Luke 5:17-26

Application

We believe in Jesus because He proved that His teachings were true by doing miracles.

Study helps

Review the meaning of authority see Study helps Lesson 15. Explain:

The word Rabbi is an official title of honor given to a teacher among the Jews. Jesus said not to use this term except in referring to him--Matthew 23:8. Jesus is the honored One, the Master Teacher.

Jesus often called himself "the Son of Man" (as in this story) which he was in part because He was born into the world by Mary. But His Father was through the Holy Spirit so He was also called the Son of God. His birth was a miracle which made him both the Son of man and the Son of God. He was the perfect man, but because He was partly man and living in a human body He understood what it was like to be a person on earth. He shared life with other people, being hungry, thirsty, and tired from work and travel. He felt human emotions of love, sorrow, joy and righteous anger. He was tempted, loved, hated, misunderstood and plotted against. But always remember that He never sinned and that He was more than just a good man. He is the only one who could ever say that He was "the Son of God."

Memory verse

Worksheet

All: Symbols--scroll Teacher Younger: After coloring and cutting out the figure of the paralyzed man (Pages of extra things), you can attach him to the picture using a clip. Perforate the worksheet from the back with the clip at the dot and then perforate the figure at the dot. Then the figure can be lying on the mat or standing in front of Jesus. Paste a piece of paper over the clip on the back of the sheet so it will stay in place.

Application

We believe in Jesus because He said His teaching was from God and we know He spoke the truth by the miracles He did.

Study helps

Start with the story of healing the man by the pool because this most likely is the miracle Jesus is referring to in 7:21 and which prompted the further attacks on Jesus. (Jesus did not break the Sabbath according to God's law as the Jews accused Him. They had added many things to God's law and made them even more important that what God had said.) The parts of chapter 7 are chosen are the ones most easily used to explain to children. Don't use a detailed account of the conversation but rather the highlights of Jesus' claims. Notice the different attitudes of different people to Jesus' teaching.

The Jews knew that the Old Testament said a king was coming from King David's family (Zechariah 9:9; Psalm 2:6; Psalm 89:3,4) but they misunderstood. They thought he would set up King David's kingdom again with Jerusalem as the capital. Even many religious people today are still looking for Jesus to come and reign on the earth but Jesus' kingdom was a spiritual one. John 6:14,15

This lesson overlaps with a lesson in the course What Kind of Book is the Bible? This time put the emphasis on the people wanting to make Jesus an earthly king because of His miracle. They were thinking of having a king who could give them food or anything else material. They missed the reason for the miracle. All of Jesus' miracles proved that He was the Messiah, the Son of God.

Study helps

The background of Acts 2 is Matthew 16:13-28 where Jesus speaks of giving the keys of the kingdom to Peter (We studied this in Lesson 11). The emphasis of this lesson is on the fulfillment of that promise and that the Kingdom is the Church. The Kingdom is not an earthly kingdom (country) but a spiritual one in the hearts of people (John 18:36,37). Neither is the Kingdom or Church a building. It is made of people called Christians with Jesus as the King. The apostles did not understand this (Acts 1:6) until after Jesus had gone back to heaven and the Holy Spirit came on them.

Jesus is greater than any earthly king. He is King of Kings and Lord of Lords (Revelation 17:14; 19:16). He will reign forever because there is no end to His kingdom (Daniel 2:44; Luke 1:33; 2 Peter 1:11; Revelation 11:15). Memory verse

1-Make the number of photo copies of the 4 pages of letters that are indicated on each page. This will give you all the letters that you need to make all 4 banner titles.

2-Cut out the letters needed for the title you need.

3-Paste them on a long strip of paper to make the title.

4-These titles are to be used:
