## Purpose of This Course

- To acquaint the students with the fact that there is a serious spiritual war for our souls going on between God and Satan.
- To help them understand how this war is being fought right now all around them and how it affects them.
- To give them Biblical reasons for not playing around with "every form of evil."
- To teach them ways to "hold fast to what is good."

## **Organization of the Course**

This course is divided into 4 Parts in 24 lessons and 2 review lessons. Each lesson has 2 worksheets, one for younger students 5 to 8 years old and one for 9 to 12 years old. There are many different kinds of exercises on the worksheets. Special memory assignments are given to each group. All scriptures are taken from the New King James Version.

Use mainly where Jesus and the apostles did miracles--as they went about the day, in the street as they found people, in houses when asked to come, etc.

#### 24-Many Different Kinds of Miracles by Different Methods Compared to Miracles Limited to Healing by Set Methods



#### Dear Christian teacher,

We are in a spiritual war between God and Satan. Whether we like it or not we are caught in the middle. God does not want us to lose our salvation in Christ but Satan is determined to do all he can draw us away from Christ by every trick he can dream up.

I decided to write this course because of many disturbing things I can see happening in the world: the evil things that are continually in the news and the things of the world I see slipping into the lives of Christians. As I have studied and researched material for this course, I have been surprised and increasingly horrified by the things I have learned about Satan's inroads into our society. To be able to make choices in the spiritual war against Satan we need to study the Bible and know more than "nice" Bible stories and that God loves us.

Let me ask you. Did you know that WICCA, with its connection to witchcraft and Halloween, has been designated an official religion in the Armed Forces and it has been mandated that they must be provided with a chaplain. Did you know that it is estimated that because WICCA is growing by leaps and bounds it will be the third largest religion in the USA by the year 2012? Did you know that there are thousands of practicing witches in the world? Did you know that the well-known Milton Bradley Company makes and sells ouija boards (an instrument of witchcraft) as if they were an ordinary game? Did you know that the Harry Potter novels are filled with genuine witchcraft and are causing many people, including children, to want to learn to become witches? Did you know the Harry Potter novels are published by Scholastics Inc, the world's largest publisher of children's books, and are being widely approved by educators and used in the school classrooms? Did you know that astrology is a religion which multitudes of people practice and thousands more believe to have some validity?

Some will argue that Harry Potter and witchcraft are "just make-believe for fun." They question if God hates and condemns something that is "just makebelieve"? I am very concerned that our children, along with many uninformed adults, are being drawn into various forms of witchcraft because it is promoted everywhere: at school, on the internet, on the TV, in the comics, as "innocent" games, and as a "fun" thing to do at birthday parties. We have to do all we can to help one another understand the tricks of Satan so we can reject the temptations that come to us from every side of life. This course has covered just some of the areas in which Satan is involved as he tries to defeat God in the Spiritual War. There is so much more, for example: what is happening to marriage and to homes, and the rank materialism of our society. Take time now to read 2 Tim. 3:1-17 to see the list of how people will think and act in the last days and see how the description fits our society. It is time for Christians to awake out of sleep and realize how cleverly Satan is worming his way into our lives and into the church. God our Father says through the apostle Paul: "And do this, knowing the time, that now **it is high time to awake out of sleep**; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. **The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light.**" (Rom. 15:11,12)

Perhaps you have never considered these things. I beg you to take seriously the Scriptures in this course and the information gathered for you in the Teacher's Helps. We cannot play with the devil without being affected spiritually. He is clever beyond our imagination. If one tactic doesn't work he will try another. The naïve and uninformed are easily deceived by him. I plead with you to take this war seriously in your own life and to help the children you teach to become aware of the devil's influence. The Bible says: "Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you." Let's do all we can to be on God's winning side and to help others to be there too!

#### The War

We are in a spiritual war for our souls and the souls of our children between **God** and **Safan**. **God** loves us and offers us salvation. **Safan** offers us fun doing sin. **Safan** cannot win in the end but he wants all the company he can get. He will use any means to capture us. He is talented at deceit and can blind our eyes to the truth if we let him. He is clever and easily tricks us into doing things his way if we are not on guard. We do not want to create unreasonable fear but rather present the seriousness of this war along with the fact that if we are on **God's** side we will have the victory over **Safan**.

#### **Our Choice**

We must choose sides between **God** and **Satan**, between **good** and **evil**, between holiness and sin, between **God** and witchcraft, between **true worship** and false worship, between **God's true miracles** and **Satan's** false miracles. It's up to us to choose but we need to be informed in order to make the right choices. We must educate our children about this war so they can make the right choices. Those choices have eternal consequences.

#### How This War Is Being Fought

"Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places." Eph. 6:11,12.

"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ." 2 Cor. 10:3-5.

"Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord." Rom. 8:37-39.

#### Characteristics of the Generals in the Spiritual War Basic: **God** and Satan are both spirits.

**God** is love and wants all to be saved; Satan is evil wanting to harm everyone he can. **God** has the power to do whatever He wants to do.

Even though he has some power Saŧan is limited by **God** in what he can do. We do not have to be afraid of Saŧan if we love **God** and do what He wants us to do.

\*NOTE about the name "Jehovah" --When the New King James Version (the one used with this course) has "Lord" written with all capital letters LORD it is where the Hebrew says "Jehovah" the name of God.

#### Misconceptions about Satan:

Lucifer--false name. See Isa. 14:12 and context!!! Written about king of Babylon (See 14:4, 22)!! False idea that he has horns and hooves, a barbed tail. (See 2 Cor. 11:13-15)

## **General Ideas for Teaching**

I hope that you will take the time to read the Bible references listed in all the Study Helps to give yourself a fuller personal as well as teacher knowledge of the spiritual war we are in. Even many adult Christians have not thought about the seriousness of this war.

Reviewing: During every Part, begin each class with a brief review of the previous lessons with emphasis on the theme of the course and of that Part. Using the chart above (Comparing God With Satan) as a sample, make a large chart to which you can add little by little with each lesson.

Memorizing Verses: Each student needs a copy of the Memory Verse Booklet according to Younger or Older. Teacher should cut them out and staple them together before the first class. Older Students--Verse word game

Enclosed in this packet are pages of the verses with words in small blocks. Each block has a key number (T-1, T-2, 1, 2, 3, 3+, 4-1, 4-2, 4-3, 4-4, 4-5) so that if the blocks are accidentally mixed up they can be easily sorted. T-1 and T-2 are the two theme verses to be used throughout the course. Numbers 1, 2, 3, indicate the main memory verse for each of those parts. Part 3 has an additional verse with the key 3+ and Part 4 has a total of 5 verses (4-1, 4-2, 4-3, 4-4, 4-5).

Make a copy of the verse block pages for each older student. Cut the words apart for the verse being used at the time. Mix the blocks up, and place each verse in a separate envelope with the student's name and the key number of the verse written on the outside of the envelope.

After spending some time memorizing the verse in class and at home, distribute the envelopes. At the word "Go!" each student or team works to be first to get the words in the correct order.

#### Theme Verses Banners

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Pages of large letters are enclosed to build the words of the verse banners. Copy the pages according to instructions on each page. The words can be pasted on a long piece of paper, or pinned to a bulletin board to be clearly seen and frequently referred to during the class sessions.

#### Projects:

#### Crossword Puzzles Project--Older:

<u>Older</u> students have two crossword puzzles, **God and His Power,** and **Satan**. As a part of each lesson certain clues are to be filled in which will help re-enforce the theme of the course. Beginning with Lesson 1, each older student needs a blank copy of the **God and His Power** puzzle and of the pages of Clues Across and Clues Down for that puzzle. Beginning with Lesson 2, the students will each need a blank copy of the **Satan** puzzle and both pages of clues. The puzzles will be used on alternate lessons through Lesson 25. Completed puzzle keys are included on pages 37 through 42 of these Helps.

#### Plaque Project--Younger

Younger students have a plaque to decorate and mount. Suggest use with Part 2.

God wants us turn away from evil and learn to do good, or be punished. Read Isa. 1:16,17; Proverbs 2:11-14; 10:23; 15:21; Rom. 1:32; 1 Tim. 5:6; 2 Thess. 2:12; Ps. 119:104-105

Some people say about games and DVDs "It's just having fun; it's not real." Other scriptures about participating in what is unrighteous. 3 John 11-- "do **not imitate** what is evil, but what is good"; 1 Tim. 5:22-- "**nor share** in other people's sins; keep yourself pure"; Rom. 1:32--" who, knowing the righteous judgment of God, that those who practice such things [a long list of sins] are deserving of death, not only do the same but also **approve** of those who practice them."

**ouija board** -- a board with alphabet and symbols on it and a planchette that when touched with fingers moves from letter to letter to spell out spiritualistic and telepathic messages, usually bad, on the board. This is divination, fortune telling, a tool of Satan, not just a game.

#### Ben Alexander's article--Dungeons and Dragons

Millions of Americans are playing it on the internet. This war game is an elaborate fantasy game fought in the minds of the players each of which takes on the identity of the character he creates, which could be either good or evil. The dungeons are full of monsters, magic and ambushes. The character uses aids such as magical weapons, potions, spells, dagger, axes, swords and such to fight his battles. As long as his character is not killed he is in the game. It is an occult game in which there becomes a very fine line between fantasy and reality. It teaches demonology, witchcraft, voodoo, murder, blasphemy, suicide assassination, sex perversion, Satan worship, gambling, divination and many other things straight from hell. Many other games also based on cruelty are being developed and marketed all the time. These games are polluting the minds of all ages and are another clever tool of Satan. Don't be taken in by the idea that they show the difference between good and evil. Most people prefer to have an evil character. Proverbs 4:23 says "Keep your heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life." We are what we think. (Read the complete article on Ben Alexander's. www.espministries.com)

#### Lesson 7 Demons Could Posses People But JESUS Cast Out Demons

Story: Legion healed by Jesus --Mk. 5:1-20.

**<u>Application</u>**: If we stay close to Jesus no demon will want to come near us. Satan tried to defeat Jesus by using demons in people but Jesus showed that He was greater and more powerful than demons and Satan.

**Study Helps:** It seems that Satan went all-out to try to defeat Jesus when He was on earth by an unusual amount of demon possession. However, Jesus came to destroy Satan (1 John 3:8; Heb. 2:14,15) and never failed to cast out demons when He encountered them. The demons knew who Jesus was and were afraid of Him. The demons talked to Jesus and He commanded them. So it should not surprise us that when people today get involved in séances would hear the voice of demons impersonating the dead person they want to hear speak.

<u>A brief summary of Ben Alexander's article Demon Possession from his web site.</u> Can Christians be demon possessed? He says, "No, demons cannot occupy the same place as the Holy Spirit." Demons can however, "perch on our shoulders" and whisper temptations to us. It is up to us whether we listen or not. He emphasizes that to defend ourselves we need to build up our supply of weapons by studying God's Word, memorizing it, and learning to pray meaningfully. The weapons we need are an abundance of are truth, righteousness, the gospel, faith, the Word of God, and salvation as pictured in Eph. 6:11-18. We can get these only through a constant study of the Bible, not by just paying our respects to it once in a while. He says, "Christians must realize they are in mortal danger without the armor of God." We must believe that Satan and his demons are very powerful enemies who can cause our spiritual death if we are not prepared. See more on --www.espministries.com

Demons are evil spirits, sometimes called unclean spirits (Mk. 1:23; Matt. 8:1`6; In the account of

the same story, Matt. 17:18 says "unclean spirit" while Mk. 9:25 says "demon");

--corrupt sound doctrine (1 Tim. 4:1-5);

--hide the truth about Christ (1 John 4:1-3);

- --have different amounts of wickedness (Matt. 12:45);
- --promote war against God (Rev. 16:14);
- --can control the one into whom they enter (Lu. 8:29); cause blindness (Matt. 12:22), insanity (Lu. 8:29), dumbness (Matt. 9:32,33), suicidal mania (Mk. 9:20-22).

**Familiar spirit** -- the spirit of a dead person, or an evil spirit or demon which serves a witch or wizard, and that a medium claims to call for a message. They bring messages between a witch and the devil. They can take the form of an animal which accompanies the witch.

# **NOTE:** Emphasize in Part 2 that Satan the father of lies and great deceiver wants us to believe that witchcraft is good and fun BUT **God** hates witchcraft in all its forms.

**NOTE**: Most dictionaries and books on the subject of witchcraft and related terms do not consider these things to be more than superstition, unfounded claims, or trickery because they do not believe that Satan is a real spirit being as the Bible teaches us. You will find words such as, "supposed," "thought to have or be," "alleged," "professes to," and such like, in the definitions and discussions of the subject. We believe the Bible.

#### This material is to give you a background to be a more effective teacher.

## **Definitions**

Deut. 18:9-12 "When you come into the land which the Lord your God is giving you, you shall not learn to follow the <u>abominations</u> of those <u>nations</u>. "There shall <u>NOT</u> be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, or one who <u>practices witchcraft</u>, or a <u>soothsayer</u>, or one who <u>interprets omens</u>, or a <u>sorcerer</u>, or one who <u>conjures spells</u>, or a <u>medium</u>, or a <u>spiritist</u>, or one who <u>calls up the dead</u>. For all who do these things are an <u>abomination to the Lord</u>, and because of these abominations the Lord your God drives them out from before you."

An abomination is something hated.

#### "Those nations" (v.9) who practiced these abominations

**Gen. 15:18-21**--On the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying: "To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates--"the <u>Kenites</u>," (lower Sinai/Horeb--may be Midianites), "the <u>Kenezzites</u>," (dwelt in part of land promised which extended from Egypt to Euphrates.), "the <u>Kadmonites</u>," (tribe of Canaan); "the <u>#Hittites</u>," (tribe of Canaan); "the <u>#Perizzites</u>," (tribe of Canaan); "the <u>#Amorites</u>," (not Canaanites); "the <u>#Amorites</u>," (Canaanite tribe; used as general term for all nations in Palestine); "the <u>#Canaanites</u>," (used as general term for all nations in Palestine); "the <u>Girgashites</u>," (tribe in Canaan); "and the <u>#Jebusites</u>." (tribe in Canaan--Jerusalem, Salem).

#### The origin and why all called Canaanites

The nations to be driven out before Israel are repeatedly named (above marked with **#)** plus <u>Hivites</u> (also a tribe in Canaan) in Ex. 3:8,17; 23:23; 33:2; 34:11. In Gen. 10:15-17 "Canaan begot Sidon his firstborn, and Heth; the <u>Jebusite</u>, the <u>Amorite</u>, and the <u>Girgashite</u>; the <u>Hivite</u>..." Num. 13:29 gives the location of "The <u>Amalekites"</u> (lived between Dead Sea and Red Sea) "dwell in the land of the South; the <u>Hittites</u>, the <u>Jebusites</u>, and the <u>Amorites</u> dwell in the mountains; and the <u>Canaanites</u> dwell by the sea and along the banks of the Jordan."

#### Some of the other nations that practiced these abominations:

Philistinians--1 Sam. 6:2 divination; Isa. 2:6 soothsayers;

Sidonians -- Jezebel 2 Kings 9:22 witchcraft; 1 Kings 16:31 -- served Baal;

Babylon --Ezek. 21:21 divination; Isa 47:9,12 enchantments, sorcery, astrologers, stargazers; Dan. 2:2; 4:7 astrologers, magicians, soothsayers, sorcerers;

Egypt -- Ex. 7:11,22; 8:7,18 sorcery enchantments; Isa. 19:3 mediums; Is. 19:3,4 charmer; Moab--Baalam--Num. 24:1; 23:23 sorcery; 22:7 diviner.

#### The practices which God said were abominations to Him

**Note:** Many of the words in Deut. 18:9-12 are interchangeable or are overlapping, or are involved in the practice of other activities listed. Sometimes it is difficult to distinguish one from the other because of the mixture of practices. Definitions are in the Helps of the lessons indicated.

witchcraft, (uses divination) (see Lessons 5, 8, 11) <u>Note: "practices witchcraft"</u> in Deut. 18:9-12 is considered by many to be a general phrase of introduction to the next more specific 7 terms.

## Hate Witchcraft as GOD does OR Practice Witchcraft: GOD, the Potter, the Creator OR Harry Potter

Story: Magicians of Egypt against God's prophets--Ex. 7:7 to 8:19.

**Application:** A great many people are excited about the Harry Potter books and are being led into witchcraft by them. We must hate witchcraft like God does and run away from such books and movies because they are evil. Remember, God wants us to hate evil and love good, not have fun with evil things.

Study Helps: God is called the potter (Creator) and we are the clay--Isa. 64:8.

God hates sorcery (witchcraft) Deut. 18:9-12. See also Isa. 8:19.

The Egyptian magicians had power to do some of the same miracles (Ex. 7:11,22; 8:7) but finally could not and recognized God as a greater power (Ex. 8:18,19).

witchcraft -- the practice of a witch or wizard who are skilled in black magic, possess supernatural powers especially by an agreement with the devil or a familiar spirit; in league with evil spirits; A witch or sorcerer casts spells, for whoever requests it for reasons such as: to turn away misfortune; to bring what someone wants; to harm or curse enemies with personal pain, sickness or death, or to bring plagues on farm animals or blight on crops. Witches also make love potions and charms as well as poisons. (See also familiar spirit, Lesson 7)

<u>one who interprets omens</u>, (*enchanter, charmer*)--<u>magician</u>, chanting for magic spell, charms, incantation. To bewitch, practice magic, enchantments, type of <u>divination</u>. Examples of divination to get a message: watching clouds, thunder, lightning, tea leaves. <u>omen</u> -- anything happening that is believed to predict a good or evil event in future, a sign. Use of omens today--open Bible at random and point at a verse--so-called message for me (Moslems do same with Koran); astrology--stargazers, monthly prognosticators (Is. 47:13,14) interpret omens.

fortuneteller -- uses divination to tell future. (Lesson 10)

channeling -- taken over by a spirit to impart wisdom.

**enchantment** -- use of any form of magic including interpreting omens, to influence by charms and incantation. To cast a spell over, bewitch. Used by a sorcerer or a magician--Ex. 7:11, 22; 8:7, 18.

incantation -- chanting words to work magic, a spell, a charm, a magical ceremony.

**<u>charmer</u>** --one who acts upon someone or a thing with a compelling or magical force; to protect with supernatural powers; use a magic formula. Example: serpent charming.

#### Summary of Ben Alexander's article, Witchcraft

Ben Alexander says in his article *Witchcraft* that he knows about witchcraft from his own personal experience of being a genuine spiritualist medium before he was converted to Christ. He was involved in "all forms of psychic phenomena from Ouija Board to materialization through ectoplasm." He conducted séances. He knows first hand that there is a real spiritual battle for the souls of men, women and children. He says we have to choose between Satan and Jesus. #### Summary of Ben Alexander's article, Harry Potter, The Truth Behind the Magic

Ben Alexander says that J.K. Rowling, the author of the Harry Potter series, consulted members of **Wicca** (see article on page 20 under Part 3 of these Helps) to write accurately about **witchcraft**. The spells in Harry Potter are like the spells and magic used by Wicca. Millions of the

Harry Potter books have been sold worldwide in numerous languages. Harry Potter appears to be a nice guy, a hero, because he overcomes bad guys. But he is a boy wizard. There is murder, violent torture, horror, and agony portrayed in the stories and they get progressively darker and uglier. Ben Alexander sees psychic phenomena (divination and casting spells) in the books.

He points out that <u>witchcraft</u> involves violence and sin according to God's word. These books portray a lifestyle completely opposite to Christianity. The books are fantasies but the facts of <u>witchcraft</u> that Rawling uses are real. He says that the publisher's (Scholastic Inc.) website has curriculum that teaches <u>witchcraft</u> to be used in the classroom with the children reading these books. They teach a satanic religion in the public schools in which <u>witchcraft</u>, talking to the dead, and reincarnation are a part. God hates these things. Children's minds are easily impressed by what they see and read. What will be the outcome? Read the complete article on **www.espministries.com** 

#### The Harry Potter Books

The argument for using these books in the school classrooms as readers is that because they are exciting, they make children want to read. Some say that Harry Potter does the things he does to help others. Paul says in Romans 6:1 "...Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound?" In other words, are we justified in doing anything, even if it is evil and sinful, if in the end it brings good in some way? God says in 1 Thess. 5:21,22 "Test all things; hold fast what is good. Abstain from *(keep away from, do not do at all)* every form of evil."

#### Lesson 9

## Resist Satan and Draw Near to GOD OR Celebrate Halloween

Story: Manasseh practiced witchcraft and many forms of evil -- 2 Kings 21:1-17.

**<u>Application</u>**: Satan is a real spirit person. God is a real Spirit but God is greater and more powerful than Satan. We have to keep God near to us and not play around with the things of Satan like Halloween.

**Study Helps:** Practicing sorcery was one thing which brought captivity on the nation of Israel--2 Kings 17:8,17; and on Judah--2 Kings 21:11-15; 2 Chron. 33:1,6. Even though King Josiah destroyed it in Judah, God still punished them--2 Kings 23:26. Israel and Judah did not resist sorcery (Ezek. 13: 6-7,18-23) but used divination and charms and were therefore punished. See the enclosed chart **Comparisons in Deuteronomy 18**.

NOTE the contrast between "celebrate" & "resist"; between "Resist" & "draw near to." James 4:7-10 <u>Celebrate</u>--to honor, to enjoy, to have fun with. We are to celebrate Jesus not Satan. <u>Resist</u>--to fight against, to refuse.

Draw near to --to get close to, to do what you can to be with.

Halloween is poking fun at the spiritual battle, pretending to be evil for fun, celebrating evil. **Please read these scriptures!** 

Pretend or play with evil is wrong. Rom. 6:1

God takes the spiritual war seriously--Eph 6:11,12.

Men love darkness but we are to follow the Light of the world-- John 3:19,20

There must not be any putting together of evil and righteousness--2 Cor. 6:14--7:1.

#### Summary of Ben Alexander's article, Halloween

Ben Alexander says that Halloween glorifies evil. It is a celebration of a night given over to the enemy in the spiritual war. It comes from Druidism which was a religion of worship of evil spirits. The symbols of Halloween: witch is the personification of evil which is a substitute for Satan; the jack-o-lantern is a representation of the fire that those who feared Satan's worst deed made to frighten away the devil; masks symbolize Satan to disguise a person so he will take their offering and not do them harm. Ben Alexander says that poking fun at the spiritual world encourages belief that it doesn't exist. God takes the evil spiritual world seriously. Satan likes us to make evil into the fun done at Halloween because it covers up his true evil nature. (To read the complete article go to: www.espministries.com

#### History of Halloween

Celts who lived in France and the British Isles had pagan beliefs: Samhain on October 31 ("Day of the Dead"; in Ireland--Satan's Watch") was a festival for the Lord of the Dead, the end of summer. Their priests (Druids) held horrible ritual fires in which they burned prisoners, criminals and animals alive to look for omens about the future and to scare demons. They believed that charms, spells and predictions of future were more powerful on Oct. 31 because more demons and evil spirits were around. If they honored the evil spirits they would help them do magic; if not, the evil spirits would punish them. People disguised themselves, roamed around doing pranks to fool demons. People offered sweet gifts to ghosts and demons to make them happy. Disguised ones threatened to call down wrath of saints if not given treats. Samhain was also a harvest and new year's festival to honor Baal who had given them a good harvest.

Roman Empire Christians tried to get rid of these pagan religions but could not. They went into partnership with evil and the things of Satan. They gave them new names and meanings. They said the fire rites would protect Christians from the Devil himself. They renamed it "All Saints Day"

to honor all Christians who had died, at first calling it "All Hallows Even." This became "Halloween." But many people still remembered the old pagan ways and feared evil spirits. Then the Catholic Church made November 2 "All Souls Day" to remember everybody who had died. Celebration of Halloween with witches, cats, demons and goblins was brought to the US by Scotch and Irish immigrants. There are today various Pagan religious groups who consider Halloween or Oct. 31 to be an important religious pagan event. There are still practicing Druids in the world today.

Halloween and pranks have always gone together. A prank is funny to everyone except the victim. Halloween ceremonies were originally used for fortune-telling rituals such as, bobbing for apples, and bonfires. People dressed in scary costumes as disguises was so evil spirits could not recognize them, and practiced trick or treat to pacify evil spirits by food and drink.

<u>"Trick or treat"</u> is not Christian. Jesus said in Matt. 5:43-45 "You have heard that it was said, 'You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust."

Jack-o-lantern -- originally the name for the night watchman carrying a lantern before electric lights were invented. Later, it became the name of a hollow turnip with candle inside to scare demons off. The pumpkin was brought from the new world to Europe and used instead of turnip. People also put a ring of candles around a corpse to keep the demons from entering it.

#### **Superstitions**

<u>Superstition</u> is the belief in things that are not so, an unreasonable fear or awe of the unknown or imaginary. i.e. "knock on wood prevents bad luck about what just said;" the number 13.

Examples of Halloween-associated superstitions: (many people carry them over to all year)

owl--bird of ill omen, bad luck or even death if seen in daytime.

midnight--witching hour, evil hour.

**graveyard**--means "dig dwelling;" cemetery means "dormitory." Belief that the dead can come back to haunt people.

Words of Fear that go with Halloween (Are there any other kind?)

spooky--Dutch for ghost; scary--timid; gruesome--to feel horror;

eerie--fearful of supernatural; weird--fate, destiny, uncanny, odd, bizarre;

skeleton--dried up thing (symbol of death);

**skull**--bald (symbol of shortness of life) Sorcerers sometimes used powdered skull of long dead criminals in magic preparations;

R.I.P. -- Latin regioescat in pace "May he/she rest in peace".

bat--(flutter mouse) a flying mammal; believe souls of dead become bats to fly at night.

**cat**--black cat cross path is bad luck; said to be "familiar" demons in animal form which serve as messengers between witch and the devil. Believed a witch could turn into a cat to do evil.

phantom--means illusion, image with no substance, a ghost.

**vampire**--in Turkish language the word for "witch." Ancient stories of vampires--blood-sucking. **monsters**. Dracula "means son of the devil."

People love to be frightened which explains the popularity of horror movies, TV and novels, like Frankenstein and King Kong. But in Phil. 4:8 God commands us to think about things that are true, noble, just, pure, lovely, and of good report.

#### Creatures about which it is believed there is nothing good

imp --a petty demon.

goblin--household spirit usually malicious; must treat properly to make friendly.

**ghost**--the old word for spirit; Long ago, people believed the soul or spirit of the dead haunted places as punishment for their sins. Now people often believe that a ghost is the soul or spirit of a dead person who visits the living to mostly do evil.

monster--bizarrely deformed human, animal, plant. Long ago people thought deformities were caused by an evil spirit.

<u>Visual aids</u>: 2 Posters--*What kind of war are Christians in?* and *What good things do these things do?* Other possible visual aids and study material about the Christian soldier can be found in Parts 3 and 4 of the course *Bible Treasures* by Margaret Elliott.

Memory Verses: Continue working on Deut. 18:10-13 and Deut 18:10-12.

**Worksheet:** Older: Be sure to discuss the box "What Kind of War Are We In?" pointing out that Christians do not use guns, etc. to fight against evil. We are in a spiritual war that involves the mind and God's Word. Also scriptures about how we are to love our enemies and pray for them, not kill or harm them. Matt. 5:43-45. "But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust." (Note also the exercises about spiritual weapons and what we are fighting against in Lessons 4; and in Lesson 7 what we fight against and what we use.)

#### Lesson 10

## GOD'S Prophets Compared to Fortune Tellers (Psychics)

**<u>Story</u>:** Maid of Philippi with a spirit of divination practiced fortune telling but Paul cast the spirit out of her -- Acts 16:16-19.

and Story: Prophet of God compared to astrologers of Nebuchadnezzar -- Dan. 2. <u>NOTE:</u> Younger students use only the story in Acts 16:16-19.

**Application:** By the example of the apostle Paul who refused the testimony of a fortuneteller and cast the spirit of divination out of her life, we should never go to anyone who claims to be a fortuneteller. Daniel, a prophet of God, was able by the power of God to tell King Nebuchadnezzar what his dream meant while the astrologers could not. God's prophets and apostles had greater power than those who worked for Satan as fortunetellers or astrologers.

**Study Helps: Psychic** -- **fortuneteller.** The psyche is the human soul. Going to a psychic is to look for soul information from the evil spirit world ruled by the devil. A psychic reading is a soul reading. A psychic is a person who sees things of the mind that are not normally known by the usual means of touch, hearing, sight, smell or taste. Psychics use a crystal ball, tarot cards, or palm reading, as means of divination or fortunetelling to give advice about all affairs of life, especially the future. In our area of Massachusetts, a psychic advertises every month "PSYCHIC WORLD. She Can and Will amaze you on your first visit. Advice on all affairs of life. Specializing in palm, tarot cards and psychic readings. Reading for your soul-mate. Schedule your House Party, Bridal Shower, Girls Night Out or Birthday Party Readings." She has also advertised, "Change your Karma" which means destiny and comes from Hinduism and Buddhism. This is not just a fun game. God is the Spirit who has already given us all we need to know about our soul, all we need to know about the spirit world. Deuteronomy 29:29 says: "The secret things belong to

# the Lord our God, but those things which are revealed belong to us..." (things revealed by Him in the Bible).

**soothsayer**, (*observer of times*)--fortune-teller, augurer (uses divination), divination with omens and signs, or chance events; claims to foretell events. <u>divination</u> (See Lesson 8); <u>omen</u> -anything happening believed to predict a good or evil event in future, a sign. Other soothsayers (diviners):Balaam--Num. 22:7; Josh. 13:22 (Lesson 4); Philistines--1 Sam. 6:2; Babylon--Ezek. 21:21,22. Diviners (soothsayers) **lie**--Jer. 14:14; 27:9,10; Ezek. 13:6-9; 22:28.

**astrologers** -- In Daniel 2:2,10 the group included "magicians, the astrologers, the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans to tell the king his dreams." Astrologers are those who profess to interpret the influence of the heavenly bodies on human affairs; stargazers. Believe that heavenly bodies control the lives of people. <u>Necromancer</u>, seeking information from the stars, determiner of fate by using the <u>horoscope</u>. Daniel said: (vs. 27,28) "the wise men, the astrologers, the magicians, and the soothsayers cannot declare to the king. But there is a God in heaven who reveals secrets," See Isa. 47:11-15.

**horoscope**--A chart in 12 parts of the heavens which shows the position of the planets with signs of **zodiac** to use to calculate events in a person's life and to give advice about the expected behavior today or in the future, according to when the person was born. This is a form of divination. Many newspapers print a daily horoscope chart for people who believe in this form of telling them what to expect for the day, what kind of character trait they will show on that day.

**<u>zodiac</u>** -- an imaginary belt among the stars where sun, constellations, and planets move. However, today none of the constellations are in their original place related to the sun when the zodiac was invented in ancient times. The signs to representing each divisions are mostly animals.

#### Lesson 11

## A sorcerer of great influence recognized the Greater miraculous power of GOD

Story: Simon the sorcerer and Philip--Acts 8:5-25.

**Application:** There are sorcerers today. Most of them call themselves witches. Many work as fortunetellers or psychics (see Lesson 10). We need to stay away from them even if a friend invites such a person to come to a party to tell everyone's fortune. What is supposedly just a fun game is really playing with sin. Remember God hates sorcery and witchcraft.

#### Study Helps:

<u>\*NOTE about the name "Jehovah"</u>--When the New King James Version (the one used with this course) has "Lord" written with all capital letters LORD it is where the Hebrew says "Jehovah" the name of God.

**sorcerer** A witch. Greek: "pharmakeia"--sorcery use of drugs, potions, spells, charms, incantations or magic words. One who uses supernatural power over others through the assistance or control of evil spirits especially for divining, <u>witchcraft</u>. Jer. 27:9,10 The Lord said: "do not listen to your prophets, your <u>diviners</u>, your <u>dreamers</u>, your <u>soothsayers</u>, or your <u>sorcerers</u>, who speak to you, saying, 'You shall not serve the king of Babylon.' For they <u>prophesy a lie</u> to you, to remove you far from your land; and I will drive you out, and you will perish."

God's lists of sins include sorcery: Deut. 18:9-14--<u>He hates;</u> Mal. 3:5--judgment for; Gal 5:20-21--<u>not in kingdom</u>; Rev. 21:8; 22:15--<u>not in New Jerusalem</u>; <u>Commands against:</u> Deut. 18:9-14; Lev. 19:26; <u>Punishment: death by stoning in Israel</u>: Ex. 22:18; Lev. 20:27; <u>Final</u> <u>punishment</u>: Rev. 21:8--second death, hell.

Memory Verses: Can the students repeat the verses from memory?

Worksheet: Younger: Patterns are found on "Worksheet Patterns for the Teacher of the Younger Students." Before class cut clothes out of cloth for both Simon and Peter. Students paste.

**Wicca:** There are hundreds of religions in the world but one of the fastest growing in the United States is Wicca. According to many people it is estimated that Wicca will be America's third religion by the year 2012. It has been recognized as a religion by the armed forces in some of their handbooks and also in some state supreme courts. There are countless attractive books and web sites teaching Wicca and how to become a <u>witch</u>. In my research about Wicca I looked into just 2 of many books available at our library written to teach people how to become a Wiccan. Both were written by witches, one a high priestess with 20 years experience in Wicca. The other author is a witch priestess with 4 witch daughters, director of internet Wiccan Pagan Press Alliance, runs a healing circle for all people of all religions as well as other Wiccan activities.

Wicca is a religion that openly practices <u>witchcraft</u>, <u>magic</u>, <u>worship of a Goddess</u>, and is based on the earth rather than heaven. They freely use the term "<u>Pagan</u>" interchangeably with "Wiccan." The <u>sun is a symbol of their god</u> and the <u>moon of their goddess</u>. Wiccans try to be in tune with nature and "walk lightly on Mother Earth." They believe that what you experience tells a person what is true and what to believe. They have no central authority or bible or rules. Some practice <u>shamanism</u> (a type of <u>witchcraft</u>) in which a person enters an altered state of consciousness in order to take a spiritual journey to get information, to heal someone, to work <u>magic</u>, to <u>tell the future</u> or to <u>talk to the dead</u>. They claim to travel between the <u>underworld</u>, the human world, and heaven. Others practice <u>tai chi</u> and are involved in <u>mythology</u> and <u>astrology</u>.

Wiccans do two types of <u>magic</u> with <u>altars</u>, tools, and other magical items. One, in order to show their own personal power and divinity, working their will to find their purpose in life. And another, for everyday <u>magic</u> or <u>spells</u> about things like finding a job or protecting their home.

Wiccan do not believe in Satan; "know" there is more than one path to God and there is no absolute right and wrong. The earth is divine, a physical part of the Goddess who gives birth to all things and receives them again at death. They have psychic power using divination (read astrological charts and tarot cards), sense the spirits of the dead. They believe each person must find their own path and moral compass. They believe in reincarnation (A soul returns to earth in a new body or form after death to have a second chance to save itself.). This is a Satanic religion.

#### Ben Alexander's article about Spiritualism ("spiritist" in Deut. 18:10-13)

Ben Alexander says that he himself once practiced spiritualism, an occult religion. The basic belief is <u>conversing with the dead</u>. They have regular church services in which they use the Bible, sing hymns, pray, and have a <u>trance</u> lecture by a <u>medium</u> or gifted speaker. They worship "God", study their ideas and beliefs of God, the universe, the spirit world and how man should live. They also do <u>healing</u> and looking into <u>psychic phenomena</u>. They hold <u>séances</u> in their church buildings in which they claim to use the 9 gifts of the Spirit (1 Cor. 12) and receive <u>messages from the dead</u>. They consider <u>Jesus as a "medium</u> of the highest order"; believe that <u>salvation is by works</u>; there is <u>no</u> devil, no death, no Hell, no need for atonement, or judgment. (Read on www.espministries.com)

#### Lesson 13

## Worshipping the **CREATOR** of the Sun, Moon and Stars OR Worshipping the Sun, Moon, and Stars

Story: Priests of God worshipping the sun -- Ezekiel 8 (especially 8:1, 15-18).

**<u>Application</u>**: Many religions of the world worship the sun, moon and stars. But we worship the One who made the sun, moon, and stars.

**<u>Study Helps:</u>** In Old Testament what God thought about worshipping the sun, moon and stars. Deut. 4:19 --warned **not** to worship sun, moon or stars.

Deut. 17:1-7 -- death to person who worships them in order to put this evil from among you.

2 Kings 23:5--Josiah destroyed worship of sun, moon, constellations, and all the host of heaven.

2 Kings 21:1-5 --King Manasseh "did <u>evil</u> in the sight of the Lord, according to the <u>abominations of the nations</u> whom the Lord had cast out before the children of Israel. ...he <u>worshiped all the host of heaven and served them.</u> He also built altars in the house of the Lord, of which the Lord had said, "In Jerusalem I will put My name...And he <u>built altars for all the host of</u>

heaven in the two courts of the house of the Lord."

In the New Testament. Rom. 1:22-26--Grave sin to worship the creature rather than Creator.

Visual Aid: Theme verses posted in classroom.

**Memory Verses:** Part 3 has two memory verses: For Lessons 13-17 use Romans 1:18,25. Lesson #18 has a separate verse. **Older:** Rom. 1:18,25 "The wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who exchanged the truth of God for the lie and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator who is blessed forever. Amen." **Younger:** "The wrath of God is against all men who worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator." (a shortened version of Rom. 1:18,25)

All: if not yet done it, start memorizing the second theme verse James 4:7,8 as time permits.

#### Lesson 14

## Worshipping GOD OR Worshipping Satan

Story: Satan tempts Jesus to worship him--Matt. 4:1-11.

**Application:** We must worship and love God who loves us, who made us and the world. Satan is evil and wants us to worship him instead of God. Jesus fought the spiritual battle with Satan by using Scripture. We should also.

**<u>Study</u>** Helps: What little words did Satan use to try to make Jesus feel like He had to prove Himself? "if" "not" "so".

To <u>worship</u> means to honor with love and loyalty, to live to please that person or object. Rom. 6:16 "Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey, whether of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness?" <u>We Are Commanded to Worship God</u> -- Ex. 20:3-6; Matt. 4:10; Rev. 19:10.

"devil" means "slanderer, one who tries to destroy a person's reputation or well-being" (Matt. 4:1; Jn. 8:44; Eph 6:11; Rev. 12:10,12).

<u>Sabbat</u> -- a secret meeting of witches and sorcerers to <u>worship the Devil</u> with rites, dances, feasts; the witches Sabbath. Also a Pagan Wiccan festival.

Satan is the force behind idols with demons as his helpers (Rev. 16:13-14). God says: "the things which the Gentiles sacrifice they sacrifice to demons and not to God, and I do not want you to have fellowship with demons." (1 Cor. 10:20) This is in the context of worshipping idols.

Discuss how people now days worship Satan. Here is a summary of

Ben Alexander's article Satanism and the Occult.

Ben Alexander begins by quoting 1 Timothy 4:1 "Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times **some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons**." He says that it is estimated that 50 million Americans are involved in some form of occult--fortune telling, tarot cards, palmistry, numerology, witchcraft, Satanism, spiritualism, New Age channeling, ouija board and séances. Besides these, also parapsychology, telepathy, clairvoyance, precognition, extra sensory perception, shamans, and voodoo. The term "occult" refers to hidden or secret things. "We have become so saturated with the world of the occult that many of us have become numb to the reality of what is happening." Young people are wearing occult and satanic jewelry (inverted pentagram, upside-down five-pointed star with goat's head, inverted broken cross), buying occult books, and deeply involved in heavy metal music with its satanic lyrics. He lists many of the music groups and gives samples of the satanic lyrics. People are into the game of Dungeons and Dragons, a game of fantasy role-playing which involves occult characters (See summary of his article about this on page 6 of these helps.

Ben Alexander points out many scriptures in which God condemns all forms of involvement with the evil spirit world. Deuteronomy 18:9-14 (which is used extensively in this course) says these things are an abomination to the Lord. (Read the complete article on his website **www.espministries.com**)

#### Lesson 15

#### Talking to GOD in Prayer OR Talking to the Dead in Séance Praying to GOD through JESUS OR Praying to God through the Saints and Mary

Story: Saul and medium of Endor--1 Sam. 28:3--20.

<u>Application:</u> Praying to anyone except God is hateful to God. We must always pray to God using Jesus' name. (1 Tim 2:5) Talking to the dead is hateful to God (Deut. 18:10-12) and a work of Satan.

**Study Helps: Background to story:** Saul's disobedience concerning Amalek--1 Sam. 15--was the reason that God did not answer his prayers. Saul had put the mediums and the spiritists out of the land (1 Sam. 28:3) but he had not really obeyed God's commandment in the law to put them to death (Lev. 20:27). His going to a medium was so offensive to God that it was one reason for Saul's death (1 Chron. 10:13).

#### Be sure to explain what a medium, a spiritist, and a séance are:.

**a medium**, (consulter with familiar spirits)--works with a spirit or demon; one who also <u>calls</u> up the spirit of a dead person who gives advice or a prophecy. Uses <u>séances</u> (See below) Medium and familiar spirit are often spoken of together. God says that anyone going to a medium or familiar spirit is defiled (Lev. 19:31). In Israel mediums and familiar spirits were to be put to death (20:6,27). Other examples in the Old Testament of using mediums: King Manassah (2 Kings 21:6) brought God's vengeance on Manasseh (2 Kings 21:11-14); Egypt (Isa. 19:3). King Josiah put them away as God had commanded in the law (2 Kings 23:24).

one who calls up the dead. (necromancer)--communicates with the dead for advice, direction or predicting the future (black, diabolical magic, <u>sorcery</u>, <u>witchcraft</u>.)

psychic -- See Lesson 10.

a <u>spiritist</u>, *(wizard*) better translation "<u>spiritualist</u>"; Spiritism is the belief that spirits of the dead can & do communicate with the living, especially thru a <u>medium</u>. (See 2 articles on Page 20)

**séance** -- a meeting of persons wishing to contact the dead through a medium. The group of from 5 to 20 people sit in a circle so all can hear. One by one the medium delivers a message from the spirit world to each person present. Some of the methods used by the spirits are rapping, tapping, moving tables, throw things about room, make objects float; things appear and disappear. In other séances the medium goes into a trance in which a spirit takes possession of medium and speaks in the voice of the dead person.

#### Why do people attend séances?

Curiosity; Want proof of life after death; Want comfort by contact with departed ones; To get advice about how to conduct their lives. **But** they are dealing with things that God hates and tells us to stay away from.

#### Praying to Mary or "the saints"

The Bible tells us that there is **one mediator** between us and God in 1 Tim 2:5,6 "For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all." Neither Mary nor any of "the saints" have given themselves as a ransom for us to take away our sins. To elevate dead human beings to be mediators is something made up by men and should be rejected completely by those who believe in following what God says.

#### Visual Aids: Poster -- God's True Way of Talking With Us.

Memory Verses: Work on Rom. 1:18,25 and Theme verse James 4:7,8,

**Worksheet:** Older: Words to paste are on Extra Things for Worksheets Older. Teacher should have words cut out and in envelopes before class. In class, students read the verses from the Bible while the teacher prints the words on the board. Students then paste words on worksheet. Explain "ransom" -- money paid to rescue a person; in the Bible, to rescue us from sin.

#### Visions, Dreams, & Prophecies From GOD OR False Visions, Dreams, & Prophecies

Story: Hananiah compared to Jeremiah--Jer. 28.

**<u>Application</u>**: The Bible contains all the visions, dreams and prophecies that God wants us to have. We must not listen to any people who claim God has spoken to them today in visions, dreams or prophecies.

**Study Helps:** Ezekiel 13 and Jeremiah 23 give extensive descriptions of the lying false prophets and their punishment. Also in Jer. 27:9,10; 14:14,15. Jesus' harsh words about false miracle workers and prophets Matt. 7:15-23; Revelation 21:8 says "all liars." will not be in heaven.

#### See the enclosed chart: Comparisons in Deuteronomy 18.

" **presume, presumptuously**, " in Deut. 18:20-22 means to speak without permission or authority. Here, of course, it means without God telling the prophet to say what he is saying.

The command "Hear the word of the Lord" is 33 times in the Bible.

The command about adding or taking away from God's words: Pro. 30:5,6; Rev. 22:18,19.

Memory Verses: Work on Rom. 1:18,25. Older: use the game word cards with code 3.

## Lesson 17

## Bowing Down to GOD OR Bowing Down to Images

Story: Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego and Nebuchadnezzar's Image--Dan. 3.

Application: God wants us to bow down only to Him and run away from idols, which God hates.

Study Helps: "bow down" means to kneel before, to worship.

Nebuchadnezzar: king of Babylonian empire; conquered Judah; burned Jerusalem and temple--2 Kings 24, 25. He brought back Hananiah, Mishael, Azariah renamed Shadrack, Meshach, Abednego: young princes of Judah--Dan. 1:3; good looking, healthy, wise, educated---Dan. 1:4. They obeyed God's command "not bow down to an image nor serve them" Ex. 20:4-6.

All important people of the empire gathered to worship Nebuchadnezzar's statue. Reminds us of when all the heads of state and many other high-ranking officials from many nations gathered at the Pope John Paul's funeral and even knelt before his casket.

In some Bible versions different words are used for the musical instruments. It seems to be difficult to exactly identify these ancient instruments.

cornet--a horn similar to a trumpet;

flute--a reed instrument played by mouth (in picture on older worksheet)

harp--a stringed instrument (see picture)

sackbut--a triangular stringed instrument, a lyre

psaltery--a stringed instrument played by plucking the strings.

dulcimer--a stringed instrument played with two padded hammers.

God hates idolatry. Compare idols and God the Creator--Ps. 96:5. We are commanded to flee idolatry--1 Cor. 10:14. Idolaters will not go to heaven--Rev. 22:15. Isaiah 44:9-20 describes the foolishness of making and worshiping idols.

Visual Aid: Chart: Comparing Idols to The Lord God is enclosed in this packet. Make a copy for each Older student to use in the class. (Also used with Lesson 20)

#### Lesson 18

#### GOD'S True Promises of Salvation Compared to Men's False Promises of Salvation

Story: The gospel message -- Acts 2:22-41; Mk. 16:16; 1 Cor. 15:1-4; Gal. 1:6-9.

**<u>Application</u>**: We must know what the Bible says in order to not fall for false promises of salvation preached by many religious people. We must check what every preacher or any other person says to see if it is what the Bible says.

**Study Helps:** God says salvation requires more than "only believe." We must believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God as well as repent of our sins and be baptized to have them washed away. Salvation by "Faith-only" often promises: wealth, no more problems, saved regardless of what do.

Must examine the message preached by any "wonder worker."

**Deut. 13:1-5** -- Even if a prophet, teacher, or preacher gives a sign <u>but</u> teaches you of other gods, do not follow. The Lord does this to prove if you really love Him.

**Gal. 1:6-9** -- Paul says that even if he or an angel from heaven would come and tell you something different from what the Bible says, that angel and Paul would be cursed.

Matt. 7:21-23 -- Many will prophesy, cast out demons and do mighty works in Jesus' name but Jesus says they are workers of sin, false prophets.

#### Visual aids: Poster--Which baptism is according to the Bible?

<u>Memory Verses:</u> <u>Both groups:</u> The special verse for this lesson is <u>Mark 16:16.</u> "He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned." <u>Older:</u> Use the game word cards 3+.

**Worksheet:** Younger: Instructions and pieces to make a paper Bible are on Extra Things for Worksheets Younger Page 1. The pattern for the cover is on Patterns for Worksheets Younger.

Older: Need the code cards. The code card key (page 34) and the answers to the message are on Page 36 of these helps. Both groups: When the worksheets are finished, staple Lessons 13-18 together with the cover for Part 3.

Lu. 5:24 -- that we may know that the Son of man has authority to forgive sins.

Lu. 7:20-22--healing miracles evidence of who Jesus is.

Acts 2:22 -- Jesus was approved of God by mighty works, wonders, signs.

Acts 14:1-3 -- the Lord bore witness to His word through signs and wonders by Paul. **4-**out of compassion for sufferers. Matt. 20:34; 15:32; Mk. 1:41; Lu. 7:13,14.

#### Our Responsibility in Regard to Miracles (Signs)

We must believe God's promises on the basis of His past miracles. Isa. 46:8-10; 1 Cor. 10:1-11 We must believe Jesus and the apostles on the basis of their miracles (signs):

Matt. 11:20-24 -- greater woe where signs done and people did not repent.

John 15:22-24 -- because of works of Jesus there is no excuse for not believing.

- Heb. 2:1-4 -- If God proved His word by signs in past we must believe His word about salvation and punishment.
- John 20:24-31 -- blessed are those who have not seen the miracles but believed the written record: testified by witnesses who heard and saw; and confirmed by God's signs through Jesus and the apostles.

There is no need of further proof. In other words, God says: "Here is the evidence, the proof. Believe, obey, and be saved; disbelieve and be condemned."

#### Why people continue to seek for signs:

For two reasons: **1.** Don't know true reason for signs; **2.** Don't want to believe anyway. Matt. 12:38-40; 16:1-4 -- an evil and adulterous generation seeks a sign.

Lu. 16:29-31 -- won't believe past signs; won't believe signs if sent now.

God did a multitude of miracles for Israel to deliver them from Egypt: Exodus 4:2-9 rod to serpent, leprous hand, water to blood; 8:2 frogs; 8:16 lice; 8:22 flies; 9:3 pestilence; 9:11 boils; 9:22 hail 10:4 locusts; 10:22 darkness; 12:29 death of firstborn; Exodus14 Red Sea opened for them and closed to kill Egyptians; Later 16:4 manna; 16:13 quail and 17:5,6 water from rock. <u>But their stubborn hearts</u> <u>did not believe.</u>

#### Why Do People Believe in Today's "Faith Healings"?

- 1. Sick people will believe with little proof anything they think might get them well.
- 2. Hopelessly sick turn to "miracles."
- 3. Sick people are looking for immediate relief.
- 4. Some find pleasure in acting the opposite of doctor's orders.
- 5. People like sensational, spectacular show, more than going to a doctor time after time.
- 6. Many sincerely believe today's "healings" are from God.
- 7. Some just want to believe in faith cures and so they do no matter what the evidence is.
- 8. Most religious people do not study the Bible but just take someone else's word.
- 9. For some it's a chance to show off their great faith.
- 10. People have a never-satisfied desire to be amazed.

#### <u>Lesson 19</u>

## GOD'S Victory Compared to Unbeliever's Failure

Story: Jesus' Death AND Jesus' Resurrection -- Luke 23 and 24; Gen. 3:15; 1 John 3:8.

**Application:** God allowed Satan to use his power to put Jesus to death. Satan wanted Him to stay dead but God who has more power brought Jesus back to life. The people who were following Satan failed to get rid of Jesus.

**Study Helps:** Lu. 22:53--Jesus said to the Jews: "This is <u>your</u> hour and the power of darkness." While Jesus was on the cross the black darkness of sin was shown when there was darkness over the land for 3 hours (Matt. 27:45). It seemed that Satan and the unbelievers were having victory. But Jesus came back to life and was the final victor. Because of His resurrection we can say with Paul: "Thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." 1 Cor. 15:57.

Jesus came to destroy Satan and his works--1 John 3:8; Heb. 2:14,15.

Visual aids: Large letter theme verse (James 4:7,8) posted in the classroom.

Memory Verses: Special for this lesson. Older: "Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Younger: (a shortened version) Scriptures" 1 Cor. 15:3,4. Use the game word cards 4-1. "Christ died for our sins, and He was buried, and He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures" 1 Cor. 15:3,4

#### Study Helps:

Dagon means "fish." The god of the Philistines, half man, half fish; had temple in Ashdod. Times when the ark of God was properly used with God's approval:

Ex. 40:3--placed in the Most Holy room of the tabernacle--later in God's temple.

Ex. 25:22--the place from which Jehovah God spoke His commands.

Num. 4:15--not to be touched; was covered and carried by priests.

Ex. 30:10; Lev. 16--High priest entered Most Holy Place once a year.

Josh. 3:14-17--divided the Jordan River by Jehovah's command.

Josh. 6:6--Jehovah commanded march around Jericho.

Visual aids: Poster--Why do idols have no power? Chart--Comparing Idols and the Lord God. You may want to make a copy for each older student if you did not do it in Lesson 17.

Memory Verses: One verse for Lessons 20 and 21. Older: Ps. 96:3-5. "Declare the Lord's glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples. ## Lesson 21

## GOD'S Prophet Succeeded But Prophets of Idolatry Failed

Story: Prophets of Baal Against Elijah -- 1 Kings 18:17-40.

**Application:** The true prophets of God did the miracles of God. The Bible tells us about the prophets from God and their teachings and actions. That is all God wants us to know.

**Study Helps:** Idols or images can do nothing. The Lord God of heaven, the Creator of the heavens and the earth can and does whatever He pleases. (Ps. 115)

**Baal**, also called Bab, Belu, Bel, means "Lord", the title of the god of Canaanites. People believed he was the Sun god who gave light and warmth and fierce heat to destroy; that he required human sacrifice in time of plague or trouble so that they burned their first-born children

alive "pass through fire" (2 Kings 16:3; 21:6). He was worshipped according to community. Each city had its own Baal--Baal-Zur, Baal-Tyre; or attached another god's name to Bel-merodach; or added some attribute--Baal-Shemain (Lord of heaven) Baal-Zebub (Lord of flies); all these gods together--Baalim; female version--Ashtaroth, Asherim.

Baal worship was highly used in Israel by King Ahab and Jezebel--1 K. 16:30-33

**Story:** Jewish exorcists compared to Paul -- Acts 19:8-20.

and Story: Peter and John heal lame man--Acts 3:1-16.

**<u>Application</u>**: God's power to do miracles <u>never</u> failed and people were amazed by what they saw. Today so-called "healers" <u>do</u> fail and use all kinds of excuses to cover up their lack of power.

Study Helps: Value of the books burned said to be: Greek money \$9,000; Jewish money \$35,000.

**Exorcist**-- a person who drives evil spirits out of another person by use of a holy name, a solemn command or magic formula. **Today** some people claim to be exorcists but like with other so-called healing miracles they are suspect.

The enclosed chart and notes **Comparing God's Miracles to So-called Miracles Today** will help you with lots of material but don't try to use all of it with the class.

The miracles at places like Lourdes, a Roman Catholic shrine--see Rev. 13:13,14; 19:20; and 2 Thess. 2:9,10.

Acts 5:14-16 gives further evidence that when the apostles healed people, all were healed.

#### Jesus healed ALL whom He tried to heal (examples)

Matt. 4:23,24; 9:35--every, all manner of diseases and sicknesses;

8:16,17--demons with a word; all sick; fulfilled prophecy;

12:15--healed them all;

14:35,36--fed **all**, **as many as** touched His garment were healed; (14:20--fed all 5,000 plus)

15:30--lame, blind, dumb, maimed, others made whole, multitude wondered;

19:2--healed multitudes; 21:14--blind and lame;

Lu. 4:40--everyone healed;

Acts 10:38 "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."

TODAY --- "Healers" select whom to "heal"; don't even try many kinds of diseases; ignore the very ill; a few seem to be healed; pray for some but see no results. Often tell people to claim healing even if they are still sick.

#### Who had to have faith?

Matt. 17:14-21--Father had faith, not the sick son,

but disciples failed because they, the healers, lacked faith -- Jesus succeeded.

Matt. 8:5-13--centurion had faith not his sick servant:

Lu. 22:50,51--servant of high priest hated Jesus, had no faith but Jesus healed him;

John 11--Lazarus was dead; sisters had faith;

Acts 3:1-11--lame man looking for alms but received healing instead.

TODAY -- If a "healer" fails to heal he blames the sick person for not having enough faith; say the sick MUST have faith. Faith of the person upon whom Jesus or the apostles performed a miracle was often NOT a factor.

#### Healings were immediate (examples)

Mk. 2:12--paralytic; Lu. 4:38,39--high fever; Acts 9:18--blind. Matt. 8:3--leper:

**TODAY**--Claimed immediate where disease can't be seen; pray for some; claim delayed action.

#### Healings were complete (examples)

Matt. 12:13--withered hand restored whole as other;

Matt.15:31--dumb spoke, maimed whole; lame walk; blind see;

Lu. 7:10--servant sick made well; John 5:5-15--infirmity for 38 years made whole;

Acts 3:2,8; 4:10--lame from birth, walking, leaping, whole.

TODAY -- Some claim healing of unseen internal illnesses; some get better; obviously in bad condition are turned away from healing; told to ignore symptoms and testify healed but just as sick or sicker; claim gradual healing (medical doctor does same).

Older: "Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people." Matt. 9:35. Cards 4-3. Younger: "Jesus went about...healing every sickness and every disease among the people." Matt. 9:35

#### Story: Miracles were performed on the spot in unprepared situations.

Spend time with as many as possible of the following Scriptures without relating many details of the stories. Use mainly where Jesus and the apostles did miracles -- as they went about the day, in the street wherever they found people, in houses when asked to come, etc. Notice that many were not even looking for healing.

Mk. 5:1-20--Jesus stepped from a boat and healed Legion;

Lu. 7:11-17--Jesus came to the city gate and raised dead man in a funeral procession; John 5:1-9--man expecting healing from a pool but Jesus saw and healed him;

Mk. 2:1-12--Jesus preaching in house when man let down from roof--Jesus healed him;

Mk. 7:32-37--Jesus took deaf and dumb man aside to heal but people amazed anyway;

Mk. 1:29-31--Went to the house and healed Peter's mother-in-law;

Lu. 17:12-19--Entering a village and healed 10 lepers who called out to Him;

Lu. 18:35-43--Healed blind beggar as He entered Jericho;

Lu 22:50,51--<u>In the garden</u>, healed ear of servant of high priest that a disciple cut off; Acts 3:1-11--Peter & John going to temple passed man sitting by gate for alms &

healed him;

Acts 16:16-18--Paul healed girl of spirit of divination in the street;

Acts 20:9,10--Paul raised from the dead young man who fell out third story window.

**Application:** Again, there is a big difference when comparing the miracles of Jesus and the apostles with the so-called "healers" today who must have just the right set-up to do their so-called miracles.

### Healer not even have to be present.

centurion's servant -- Matt. 8:5-13; nobleman's son -- John 4:46-53; Canaanite woman's daughter -- Matt. 15:22-28 <u>TODAY</u> the healer has to always be present. Jesus requested NO Publicity

**Application:** For our wonderful Jesus and the apostles no miracle was too difficult and they used whatever method useful according to the circumstances.

#### Study Helps:

**TODAY**--So-called healers try to heal only certain kinds. Their only methods are laying on hands and prayer. They do not even attempt to calm storms, walk on water, raise the dead, etc.

In the Old Testament, God used many different kinds of things and the miracles were performed in various ways in Egypt. See Older Student's worksheet and page 27 of these Helps "Why people continue to seek for signs."

Heb. 2:4 "God also bearing witness both with <u>signs</u> and <u>wonders</u>, with <u>various miracles</u>, and <u>gifts</u> of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will." Acts 2:22 " Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by <u>miracles</u>, <u>wonders</u>, and <u>signs</u> which God did through Him in your midst."

wonders--something strange causing people to marvel: ex. burning bush for Moses. signs--something unusual that shows divine authority: ex. gift of tongues, gift of prophecy.

Anytime we get fun out of things involving witchcraft we are playing a dangerous game. God says He hates witchcraft. To understand how serious it is to play around with such things we have to read Deut 18:10-13, which says: "There shall not be found among you anyone ... who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead. For all who do these things are an abomination to the Lord. You shall be blameless before the Lord your God." The Bible also tells us that anyone who practices sorcery will not inherit the kingdom and will not be in heaven (Gal. 5:20,21; Rev. 21:8).

The Bible verses in the letterhead of this letter are commands and promises from God our loving heavenly Father. We must prayerfully consider where the world and Satan's tricks are leading us and our children. Let's draw near to God!
