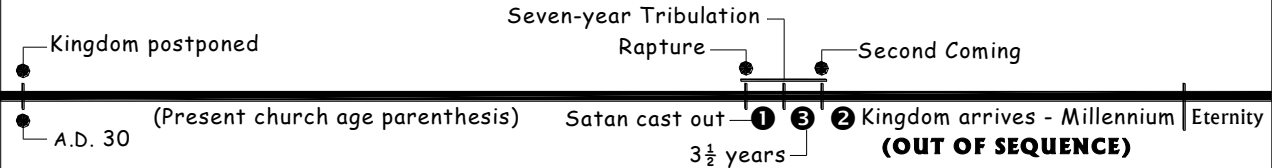


Arrival of Kingdom as Seen in Revelation 12

Futurist view, contrary to Rev. 12, places arrival of kingdom AFTER "3½ years":

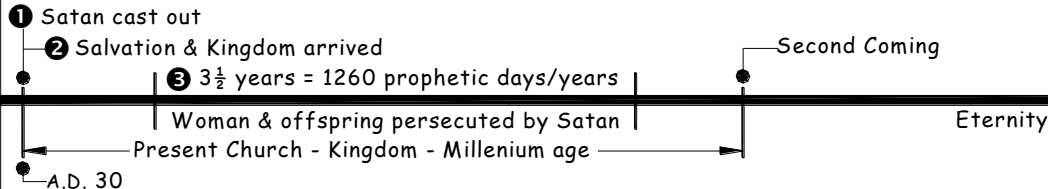


Rev. 12:9-14 reveals the following sequence:

- ① Satan is cast out of heaven by the blood of Jesus.
- ② That is when salvation and the kingdom arrive.
- ③ Then, the persecuted woman flees to the wilderness for 3½ years.

Futurist and historical views agree:
 1260 days = "time, times, and half a time" = 3½ years,
 1 day = 1 year for 70-week prophecy using Ezek. 4:6 key,
 BUT
 only the historical view applies this key to the 3½ years.

Historical view, agreeing with Rev. 12, places arrival of kingdom BEFORE "3½ years":



The kingdom arrived with salvation in A.D. 30.
