

# TWO LITTLE HORNS IN DANIEL

## Two Very Different Enemies of God

DANIEL 8:8-14, 21-26



DANIEL 7:7-8, 20-25



① He is part of the **male goat**, which is the **Grecian Empire**.

① He is part of the **terrible fourth beast**, which is the **Roman Empire**.

② The male goat has **four horns**, which are the **four divisions** of the Grecian Empire after Alexander the Great.

② The terrible beast has **ten horns**, which are the **ten divisions** of the Roman Empire after the fall of Rome.

③ He comes **out of one** of the four divisions, that is, out of **Syria**.

③ He **plucks up and replaces three** of the divisions of the Roman Empire.

④ This little horn, **Antiochus Epiphanes**, takes away the daily sacrifices of the temple.

④ This little horn, **the Papacy**, speaks blasphemies and changes laws.

⑤ He fights **against the Jews**, God's people under the Law.

⑤ He fights **against the Christians**, God's people under the Gospel.

⑥ He has power over the sanctuary for **2,300 days**, from Sept, 171 B.C. to Dec, 165 B.C.

⑥ He has power over the saints for **"3½ times"** (1,260 years), from A.D. 533 to A.D. 1793.
