Two very different Effernies of God	
DANIEL 8:8-14, 21-26	DANIEL 7:7-8, 20-25
He is part of the male goat, which is the Grecian Empire.	He is part of the <u>terrible fourth beast</u> , which is the <u>Roman Empire</u> .
The male goat has <u>four horns</u> , which are the <u>four divisions</u> of the Grecian Empire after Alexander the Great.	The terrible beast has <u>ten horns</u> , which are the <u>ten divisions</u> of the Roman Empire after the fall of Rome.
He comes <u>out of one</u> of the four divisions, that is, out of <u>Syria</u> .	He <u>plucks up and replaces three</u> of the divisions of the Roman Empire.
This little horn, Antiochus Epiphanes, takes away the daily sacrifices of the temple.	This little horn, the Papacy, speaks blasphemies and changes laws.
He fights <u>against the Jews</u> , God's people under the Law.	He fights <u>against the Christians</u> , God's people under the Gospel.
He has power over the sanctuary for 2,300 days, from Sept, 171 B.C. to Dec, 165 B.C.	He has power over the saints for (a) "3½ times" (1,260 years), from A.D. 533 to A.D. 1793.
